Camping Etiquette

1. Please follow all campground/park rules first and foremost!
2. Remember that you are representing Pack 515 and you are representing the Cub Scouts of America. **Show respect** to all campers, park rangers, scout leaders, and other adults.
3. **PLEASE DO NOT LET YOUR CHILD PLAY WITH THE CAMPFIRES!** They should not be throwing anything in the fire and should not hold sticks and branches in the flames and then lifting them out of the fire. This is a major safety and fire hazard.
4. At the request of the park rangers...**For the safety of the children please be sure they are accompanied by an adult to and from the restrooms as there is constant traffic. Since you will be in the campground with other visitors please be sure that the children and others of your group are considerate and courteous to the other visitors (no loud or rowdy behavior).**
5. If your family brings bikes...please do not allow your child to ride around the campground area unless an adult is with them. Remind them to stay on the marked road and off campsites. We prefer that all bike riding be outside the actual campground area. Thank you for your understanding!
6. Scouts will not be allowed to play "man hunt" (especially at night). This game has gotten our boys in trouble in the past for running through campsites and the noise level not to mention at least one boy always gets hurt playing this game.
7. If we receive complaints about specific boys not following the camping expectations, it may jeopardize their next camping opportunity.
